Multiple Email Accounts

Sometimes there are Engineers and Vendors that do work for more than one company that use Angus AnyWhere™. In these cases they might be using only one BlackBerry® but it might have multiple e-mail addresses on it or they will have a BlackBerry® with more than one service book. E-mail addresses are unique to profiles and can only be entered once, so you will enter the respective e-mail address under the correct profile.

- As long as both e-mail addresses work and they can send and receive email, setup the Engineer as you normally would, for RIM Data or RIM attachment.
- The Engineer can receive work orders in his BlackBerry® through Angus AnyWhere™ for both sites and complete them as normal.

Note:

- If you are unsure of how to obtain an e-mail address for the BlackBerry® that is not provided by the
 service provider or via the BES (BlackBerry® Enterprise Server), one can be used from any free e-mail
 service. Example If they want to use a Yahoo account, all you need to do is go to their website, sign up
 for a free account, and make note of the e-mail address and password used to log into the account.
- 3. Once you have the additional e-mail address, the next step will be to have it added to the BlackBerry®.

Notes:

- If you are unsure of how to get an e-mail added to a BlackBerry®, this can be done from the web client
 for your BlackBerry® service provider or by calling their technical support. They will need the e-mail
 address and password used to access the e-mail. Then ensure the service book is sent to the device.
