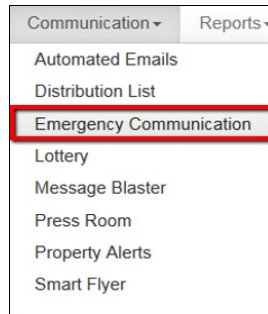

About Emergency Communication:

Emergency Communication is a building safety tool to keep all building personnel informed of arising threats, emergency contact information, building emergency procedures, and weather tracking information. As threats arise, Property Managers have the option to create pop-up notifications that display on the portal.
