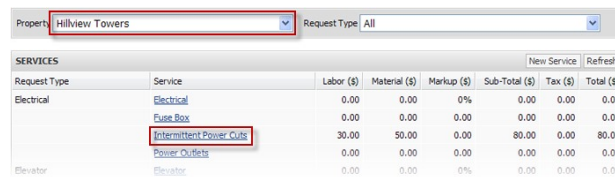

Deleting a Service:

1. Go to **Control Panel > Work Order > Tenant Requests > Service Schedules**.

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2. In the **Filter** section, click on the **Property** field and select the desired property from the drop-down list.
